## AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES & ATHLETICS PROGRAM

### What is the program about?

The AOSR **After School Activities (ASA) & Athletics Programs** offer a selection of sports, art, music, technology, and more for all students in grades K - 12.

### Philosophy

ASA and the Athletics Program augment the AOSR experience by providing further opportunity for our students to pursue engaging English language activities in a challenging and fun environment where students learn and build friendships.

Through the various offerings, students have the chance to gain new skills, while coaches and teachers work to cultivate qualities such as; teamwork, discipline, dedication, respect, and communication. All sports and activities are open to all students.

### When & where these activities happen?

The After School Activities & Athletics program will run from Monday, January 28th, 2019 to Friday, May 24th, 2019. The activities take part from Monday to Friday from 15:30 to 17:00 at AOSR campus.

For Session 2, the number of session per days is as follow:

- **MONDAY** - 15 sessions
- **TUESDAY** - 15 sessions
- **WEDNESDAY** - 14 sessions
- **THURSDAY** - 15 sessions
- **FRIDAY** - 14 sessions

The following days the After School program won't run due to holidays or scheduled school activities.

## How do I enroll?

2. Register online by filling out the form for **After School Activities** on the AOSR website
  - a. The form will be active for you to complete the registration on **Monday, January 1st, 2019 at 08:00 hrs.**
  - b. The form will close on **Friday, January 18th 2019 at 23:55 hrs.**
3. Get ready to start on September Monday, January 28th!

## Enrollment Requirements: Doctor's Certificate

For all sports activities is required a doctor's certificate, in Italy, this certificate is commonly named as **Certificato Sportivo Non-Agonistico** and is required by law to participate in school-sponsored sports and it has to be valid for one calendar year from when it's done.

Students without the corresponding certificate before the due date will not be able to participate in the ASA program until the certificate is received.

## How much will it cost?

Prices for After School Activities Session II 2018-2019 per student are as follows:

- One day per week:
  - Sports, Arts or Tech: € 150
  - Cooking, ES Makerspace: € 200
- Swimming for MS & HS:
  - Two days a week: € 350

\* Cooking and makerspace classes are more expensive due to higher overhead costs.

\* Swimming is an activity that has to be taken two days a week.

\* There is an additional registration fee of € 80 for all non-AOSR students.

\* Families who enroll at AOSR during the school year will be offered a prorated cost for the current After School Activities session.

\* There will be no refunds after activity payment.

## How can I pay?

- Payment must be only to the school cashier in the Villa office, open from Monday to Friday, from 9:00 to 16:00

## Transportation

The 5:15 pm bus service is available with a limited number of bus stops ONLY for students who are regularly signed up for after-school activities or in supervised extra-curricular activities organized by the school.

- Kindergarten students are not allowed to ride the 17:15 buses.
- Students in Grade 1 through Grade 3 may not take late buses home unless the ASA Bus Permission Form is filled in and approved by the Bus Coordinator.
- Students leaving campus at 15:30 hrs are not authorized to re-enter to use the late bus service.

## **Notification of Absence & Changes of Schedule to Bus Services**

For any absence notifications or changes regarding the bus service, parents must inform the school in writing by e-mailing at [buschanges@aosr.org](mailto:buschanges@aosr.org) and with a carbon copy (CC) to [asa@aosr.org](mailto:asa@aosr.org) and your corresponding District School Office. A written notice is required by law if the student is a minor.

**For changes on the same afternoon, notification should arrive before by 14:00 hrs the same day.**

## **On-Campus After School**

Students must be enrolled/participating in an official school sport or activity to be able to remain on campus after 15:30 hrs., students in ASA and Athletics who do not ride the late bus must be picked up promptly by 17:00 hrs.

## **Pre/post activity pick-up location**

- Elementary School students will meet their After School instructor or coach at the green area in front of the ES Principal Office at 15:25.
- The post-activity pick-up will be in front of the ASA Office at 17:00, not at the activity location.

## **Student Behavior expectations (Sportsmanship & Teamwork)**

Coaches/teachers are responsible for our ASA students from pickup to drop off. ASA students are expected to follow all school rules and the directions of the coach/teacher.

Representing AOSR on a sports team is a privilege and not a right. Coaches prioritize sportsmanship and teamwork over winning and work to instill these qualities in our student-athletes. Behavior not inline with sportsmanship and teamwork, on and off the field and in training or in games, may result in the removal from the team immediately.

## Activity Observation

We kindly request parents to limit their presence during the lesson. Though we completely understand the desire to remain and watch your children in their given activity, student participation improves greatly when they are fully engaged. We will provide dates for lessons/demonstrations and games open to all.

## Rain

In the case of light rain, all ASA Athletic Activities will proceed as normal. Please pack appropriate clothing for your son/daughter to participate in all types of weather.

In the case of heavy rain activities will be moved indoors. If the gym is not available due to previously scheduled athletic activities, teams will proceed to classrooms for activities and discussion. No reimbursement will be made due to rainy days.

If your student-athlete will not be participating on any given activity day, please be sure to inform the Bus Coordinator Office, ES Office, ASA Office, and Classroom Teacher no later than 14:00 hrs.

## Sports competition schedules

Most athletic games/competitions are scheduled for Saturday mornings and afternoons with occasionally Friday evenings. Team specific calendars can be found on the Athletic Google Sites or AOSR Sports Google calendar.

## Swimming

The swimming lessons will take place on Pangaro Team Piscina located at **Via Lucio Cassio 48, Roma 00819**.

Please review below the specific schedule for this activity.

- 7:10 hrs - Students meet with the instructor at the pool, they need to be ready to get into the water.
- 7:20 hrs - 8:10 hrs - Students take the lesson. Pool time.
- 8:40 hrs - Students depart the pool by foot with coach (rain or shine)
- 8:50 hrs - Students arrive at AOSR Campus.
