NEW STUDENT FEES

Capital Assessment Fee (per new family)	€ 5.500,00
Registration Fee (per new student)	€ 800,00

The Capital Assessment is a one-time fee charged the first year to a new family to attend AOSR. This fee is assigned to a fund specifically designed for capital investments. The Capital Assessment Fee is not refundable and is not pro-rated according to attendance or date of entry during the school year. The Registration Fee is a one-time mandatory and non-refundable fee and is due once a place at the school has been offered and accepted.

The Capital Assessment and Registration Fees are due upon receipt of the invoice and payment will guarantee the student(s) a place until the tuition fees are invoiced and paid.
